Former U.D. Athlete Sentenced
State v. Jalen Robinson 2015-CR-0887/2

DAYTON, OH (07/01/2015) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that former University of Dayton student, **Jalen T. Robinson**, 21, was sentenced for his part in a series of burglaries committed on campus.

During the early morning hours of Sunday, December 14, 2014, a number of University of Dayton dormitory rooms were broken into and property stolen. In addition to video surveillance, two defendants, Jalen Robinson and Devon Scott, were positively identified.

The next day, Monday, December 15, 2014, both defendants, who were on the roster of the University of Dayton Men's Basketball team, were dismissed from the team. Subsequently both defendants withdrew from the University of Dayton.

On June 12, 2015, the defendant was found guilty of three counts of Trespass in a Habitation, fourth degree felonies.

Today, the defendant was sentenced to serve 30 days in the Montgomery County Jail, pay full restitution to the victims, and was taken into custody. When released, he will be on Community Control Sanctions (Probation) for five full years.

Co-defendant Scott was arrested on seven counts of Burglary. His case will proceed to the Grand Jury.
