**Two Former U.D. Athletes Charged**

***State v. Jalen Robinson & Devon Scott 2015-CR-0887***

**DAYTON, OH (03/24/2015)** – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that charges have been approved against two former University of Dayton students, **Jalen T. Robinson**, 21, and **Devin Henry Scott**, 20, for a series of burglaries committed on campus.

During the early morning hours of Sunday, December 14, 2014, a number of University of Dayton dormitory rooms were broken into, from which items were stolen. In addition to video surveillance, the defendants were positively identified.

The next day, Monday, December 15, 2014, both defendants, who were starters for the University of Dayton Men's Basketball team, were dismissed from the team. Subsequently both defendants withdrew from the University of Dayton.

Today, complaints and arrest warrants have been filed, charging defendant Scott with seven counts of Burglary, and defendant Robinson with three counts of burglary. All of the counts are second-degree felonies. The arrest warrants are nationwide as the location of the defendants is unknown at this time.

This is an ongoing and continuing investigation. There is extensive forensic analysis that needs to be completed involving numerous victims, and it is anticipated that additional charges may be forthcoming.

This case will be presented to the Montgomery County Grand Jury.
