Kettering Man Indicted for Murder of Girlfriend

State v. Terrel Ross, 2020-CR-233

DAYTON, OH (01/29/2020) – Montgomery County Prosecutor Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **TERREL MANDRED ROSS**, 37, of Kettering, has been indicted for the stabbing death of his girlfriend, whose body was found in a trash dumpster on January 18, 2020.

Kettering police officers were dispatched to an apartment complex on Aberdeen Avenue on Saturday, January 18, 2020, on a report of a body that had been discovered in a trash dumpster. The victim was identified as 24-year-old Sierra D. Woodfork. The victim lived at the apartment complex with the defendant, her boyfriend. The coroner determined the victim died as a result of multiple stab wounds.

Today, the Montgomery County Grand Jury indicted the defendant on:

- Two counts of Murder
- Two counts of Felonious Assault
- Three counts of Tampering With Evidence
- One count of Gross Abuse of Corpse

The defendant is currently in custody in the Montgomery County Jail, being held on a \$1,000,000 bond. He will be arraigned on Tuesday, February 4, 2020, at 8:30 a.m.
