Dayton Man Found Guilty and Sentenced in Decade Old Cold Case

State v. Theodore Satterwhite, 2014-CR-4075

DAYTON, OH (04/11/2016) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that 34 year old **Theodore S. Satterwhite, III**, of Dayton, has been found guilty for a homicide and shooting that occurred in 2005.

On Thursday, November 3, 2005, the victims, 22 year old Roscoe Shipp and his friend, Deandre White, were shot while leaving JP's Bar and Grill at 514 North Gettysburg Avenue in Dayton. Mr. White survived the shooting.

Following an extensive investigation by the Dayton Police Department Cold Case Unit, the defendant was identified for his involvement.

Today, the defendant was found guilty of Involuntary Manslaughter and Felonious Assault. In addition, the defendant was convicted of a mandatory firearm specification.

The defendant was sentenced to six years in prison.
