Former Juvenile Justice Center Worker Indicted for Sexual Battery

State v. Megan Schroeder, 2016-CR-2852

DAYTON, OH (12/14/2016) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that 27-year-old **MEGAN ELIZABETH SCHROEDER**, of Dayton, has been indicted on charges relating to having a sexual relationship with a juvenile detained in the Montgomery County Juvenile Justice Detention Center.

The defendant was employed as a Youth Leader for the Juvenile Cognitive Alternative Rehabilitation Effort (JCare). The victim disclosed to staff that the defendant had engaged in a sexual relationship with the juvenile on at least two occasions. The staff reported the disclosure to the Sheriff's Office for investigation.

Today, the defendant was indicted on:

- Two counts of Sexual Battery

The defendant's employment with the court was terminated. The juvenile involved has since turned 18 years old. He is currently incarcerated at Madison Correctional Institution having been convicted in the case for which he was being detained.

The defendant is scheduled to be arraigned on December 29, 2016, at 8:30 am.
