**Second Former U.D. Athlete Found Guilty**

*State v. Devon Scott 2015-CR-0887/1*

**DAYTON, OH (07/08/2015)** – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that former University of Dayton student **Devon Henry Scott**, 21, was found guilty of two counts of Burglary and three counts of Trespass in a Habitation.

During the early morning hours of Sunday, December 14, 2014, a number of University of Dayton dormitory rooms were broken into, from which items were stolen. In addition to video surveillance, the defendants were positively identified.

The next day, Monday, December 15, 2014, defendant Scott and co-defendant Jalen T. Robinson, who were starters for the University of Dayton Men's Basketball team, were dismissed from the team. Subsequently both defendants withdrew from the University of Dayton.

On March 24, 2015 complaints and arrest warrants were filed, charging both defendants.

Defendant Scott was found guilty as charged to two counts of Burglary, second degree felonies, and three counts of Trespass in a Habitation, fourth degree felonies.

Further conditions of the plea:

- The defendant will be placed on Community Control Sanctions for a full five (5) years;
- That the defendant, as part of community control sanctions, will serve 90 days in jail;
- Full restitution will be ordered.

The defendant will be sentenced on August 5, 2015 at 2:00 p.m.
