Second Former U.D. Athlete Sentenced

State v. Devon Scott 2015-CR-0887/1

DAYTON, OH (08/05/2015) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that former University of Dayton Men’s Basketball player and student **Devon Henry Scott**, 21, was sentenced for his part in a series of burglaries committed on campus.

During the early morning hours of Sunday, December 14, 2014, a number of University of Dayton dormitory rooms were broken into from which items were stolen. In addition to video surveillance, two defendants, Scott and Jalen Robinson, were positively identified.

The next day, Monday, December 15, 2014, the defendants, who were on the roster of the University of Dayton Men’s Basketball team, were dismissed from the team. Subsequently both defendants withdrew from the University of Dayton.

Defendant Scott was found guilty as charged on two counts of Burglary, second degree felonies, and three counts of Trespass in a Habitation, fourth degree felonies.

The defendant was sentenced to serve 90 days in the Montgomery County Jail, pay full restitution to the victims, and receive Community Control Sanctions (Probation) for a five full years when released. The defendant was taken into custody immediately following the sentencing hearing to begin serving his sentence.

On July 1, 2015, co-defendant Robinson was sentenced to 30 days in jail and was also ordered to pay full restitution and serve five full years of probation.
