Dayton Man Sentenced for Second Attempted Murder Conviction

State v. Shaquille Shackelford, 2020-CR-2219

DAYTON, OH (3/25/2022) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **SHAQUILLE PHILLIP SHACKLEFORD**, 29, of Dayton, was sentenced to at least 34-and-a-half years in prison after being convicted on counts related to the shooting of a 27-year-old woman on May 8, 2020, in Moraine.

In the early morning hours of Friday, May 8, 2020, the defendant was a rear-seat passenger in a vehicle in the parking lot of the Red Roof Inn in Moraine. The defendant got into a dispute with another passenger in the vehicle. When the female driver tried to intervene, the defendant pulled out a firearm and fired multiple rounds into the back of the driver's seat, striking the victim. The victim was left paralyzed.

On September 18, 2020, the defendant was indicted of counts of Attempted Murder, Felonious Assault with a deadly weapon, Felonious Assault causing serious harm, Improper Handling of a firearm in a motor vehicle, and two counts of Having Weapons While Under Disability.

On March 2, 2022, after a trial, a jury returned verdicts of guilty as charged.

Today, the defendant was sentenced to the maximum, consecutive sentence of at least 34-and-a-half years in prison. The sentence was ordered to be served consecutive to the 20-year sentence the defendant received in May after he was convicted of attempted murder and other charges for the shooting of a man multiple times on May 11, 2020, in Dayton.
