**Assistant Prosecuting Attorney Emily E. Sluk  
Assigned to Child Abuse Bureau**

*Will prosecute felony child abuse cases*

**DAYTON, OH (8/14/2015)** – Montgomery County Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced that Ms. Emily Sluk has been assigned to the position of Assistant Prosecuting Attorney in the Child Abuse Bureau, (CAB), of the Prosecutor's Office, located at CARE House (the local children's advocacy center.)

Ms. Sluk received her law degree from the University of Dayton School of Law in 2007. Emily joined the prosecutor's office in April 2008 and was assigned to the Juvenile Division. In February 2010, she was assigned to the Intake/Grand Jury Section before being promoted to Criminal Docket Attorney in August 2011. Emily left the office in May 2013 to work in the Miami County Prosecutor's Office, but returned to our office in August 2014 and was assigned as a Criminal Docket Attorney.

As an Assistant Prosecuting Attorney in CAB, she will prosecute felony child abuse cases, including physical and sexual abuse cases, for which the victim is less than 13 years old; where the victim is 13-18 years old and the offender is a family or household member; and where the victim is up to 21 years old and is mentally or physically handicapped.

Prosecutor Heck said, "Emily has extensive experience as a criminal docket prosecutor, handling a variety of cases. Her successful trial experience and genuine concern for victims will be instrumental in handling these sensitive cases."
