**Miamisburg Man Indicted for Aggravated Murder**

*State v. Tony Lee Smith, Jr., 2022-CR-1030*

**DAYTON, OH (04/15/2022)** – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **TONY LEE SMITH, JR.**, 27, of Miamisburg, has been indicted on counts in connection to the April 6, 2022 shooting death of Dylan Judd, 28, of Miamisburg.

On the afternoon of Wednesday, April 6, 2022, the Miamisburg police were dispatched to a residence in the 1100 block of East Pearl Street on a report of an injured person. Upon arrival, they located the victim, identified as 28-year-old Dylan Judd, lying in a pool of blood inside the home. The victim has been shot two times in the head. He was pronounced deceased.

Further investigation, including video surveillance from the area, identified a possible suspect, wearing a backpack, who had arrived and then left the scene on a bicycle. At about 5:30 p.m., officers located the bicycle near the intersection of North Twelfth Street and East Central Avenue. The officers canvassed the area and located the suspect wearing a backpack. Inside the backpack, officers located items that had been stolen from the victim's home.

Today, the Montgomery County Grand Jury indicted the defendant for:

- 4 counts of Aggravated Murder
- 2 counts of Murder
- 2 counts of Aggravated Robbery
- 2 counts of Aggravated Burglary
- 2 counts of Felonious Assault
- 2 counts of Tampering with Evidence

All of the counts, except for the tampering with evidence counts, include 3-year firearm specifications.

The defendant is currently being held in the Montgomery County Jail on a \$500,000 bond. He will be arraigned on Tuesday, April 19, 2022, at 8:30 a.m.
