Kettering Man Indicted for Aggravated Murder

State v. Sean Sorrentino, 2015-CR-1615

DAYTON, OH (06/11/2015) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that 31 year old **Sean T. Sorrentino**, of Kettering, has been indicted for murder and other charges stemming from an incident on June 2, 2015.

The defendant and the victim, Allen D. Samuels, were neighbors in an apartment building for chronically homeless and/or disabled persons on Westcliff Court in Kettering. On Tuesday, June 2, 2015, the defendant attacked the victim inside the victim's apartment with a kitchen knife. A manager tried to intervene, but the defendant assaulted him and continued his attack on the victim, repeatedly stabbing the victim, causing his death.

Kettering Police Officers arrived and located the defendant, the deceased victim, the injured building manager, and immediately took the defendant into custody.

Today, the defendant was indicted on:

- One count of Aggravated Murder while committing aggravated burglary
- One count of Aggravated Burglary
- Two counts of Murder while committing felonious assault
- Two counts of Felonious Assault
- One count of Burglary
- One count of Assault

The defendant is currently in custody in the Montgomery County Jail, being held on a \$500,000 bond. He is scheduled to be arraigned on June 16, 2015 at 8:30 a.m.
