**Riverside Man Indicted for Murder of Father**

*State v. David Streeter, 2020-CR-473*

**DAYTON, OH (02/18/2020)** – Montgomery County Prosecutor Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **DAVID E. STREETER**, 30, of Riverside, has been indicted for the murder of his father, 69-year-old Donald Streeter on or about February 8<sup>th</sup> or 9<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

On February 9, 2020, Riverside Police were dispatched to a home on Robinwood Avenue on a report of a deceased elderly man. When they arrived, they located the deceased body of the victim inside the home. It was apparent the victim had been beaten.

Further investigation revealed the defendant, the adult son of the victim, had beaten the man with a metal broom handle. The defendant lived in the home with his parents.

Today, the Montgomery County Grand Jury indicted the defendant on:

- Two counts of Murder
- Two counts of Felonious Assault

The defendant is currently in custody in the Montgomery County Jail, being held on a \$1,000,000 bond. He will be arraigned on Thursday, February 20, 2020, at 8:30 a.m.
