43 Year Old West Carrollton Man Indicted for Child Pornography

State v. Charles Stutz, 2020-CR-1817

DAYTON, OH (10/27/2020) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **CHARLES DD STUTZ**, 43, of West Carrollton, has been indicted on 54 felony counts in connection to child pornography.

On Thursday, January 23, 2019, a citizen contacted the Moraine Police Department to report that he had an SD memory card that contained a large amount of child pornography. The citizen reported that the card had been found outside a Moraine cell phone store. A forensic examination of the memory card determined it belonged to the defendant.

On March 15, 2019, a different citizen contacted the West Carrollton Police Department to report that the citizen had accidentally located child pornography on the defendant's cell phone. The phone was forensically analyzed, and numerous videos and photos of child pornography were located.

The images were sent to the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children (NCMEC), and in 18 of the videos/photos, the NCMEC was able to identify the child depicted in the images.

Today, the Montgomery County Grand Jury indicted the defendant for:

- One count of Pandering Obscenity Involving a Minor
- 53 counts of Pandering Sexually Oriented Material Involving a Minor

A warrant has been issued for the arrest of the defendant. He is scheduled to be arraigned on Tuesday, November 10, 2020, at 8:30 a.m.
