Dayton Man Guilty in Deadly Dice Game

State v. Roemallo Taylor 2014-CR-1611

DAYTON, OH (3/2/2015) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that 20-year-old **Roemallo D. Taylor**, of Dayton, pleaded guilty to charges relating to the shooting death of 26-year-old Gregory T. Alexander.

On April 30, 2014, Taylor and the victim argued over a dice game taking place in the Desoto Bass housing development. During the argument, Taylor brandished a firearm demanding that the victim pay him money that was owed as the result of a gambling debt. The victim was able to disarm Taylor of the firearm and walk to a nearby apartment. The defendant followed the victim to the apartment and a struggle ensued, ending with the defendant shooting the victim one time in the abdomen. The victim died as a result of the gunshot wound.

The Defendant was found guilty to today of:

- One count of Involuntary Manslaughter
- One count of Having Weapons While Under Disability

The defendant will be sentenced on March 26, 2015 at 11:45 a.m.
