Sentencings

In June, 2018, we disposed of 275 cases. The Judges sentenced the defendants in those cases as follows:

- 56.0% received Community Control Sanctions (probation)
- 23.3% were sentenced to the penitentiary
- 14.5% were granted Intervention in Lieu of Conviction (ILC)
- 6.2% received local jail time or local jail time plus probation

Some notable sentences:

- 6/14/2018 Ronald Stone was sentenced to 8 years in prison for committing an armed robbery in the parking lot of the WalMart on Miller Lane in Butler Township on January 30, 2018. The defendant held a gun to the head of a woman as she was walking to her car after a late night shopping trip. The defendant, along with two co-defendants, then fled the scene. Co-defendant Tyvon Mansell was sentenced to 6 years in prison on May 29, 2018 for his part in the robbery. The third co-defendant, Jamal Gay, was convicted of Obstructing Justice for his minimal actions in the incident, and was sentenced to probation on June 14, 2018.
- 6/26/2018 Samantha Clay was sentenced to a total of 3 years in prison after being convicted on a number of charges, including Engaging in an Pattern of Corrupt Activity, Illegal Sexual Activity in a Sexually Oriented Business, Trafficking in Cocaine, Aggravated Trafficking in Drugs, and Illegal Use of Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program Benefits or WIC Program Benefits. The defendant worked at The Harem in Harrison Township and was identified as one of several defendants involved in prostitution and drug trafficking at the business.

- 6/26/2018 Joshua Hardy was sentenced to a total of 10 years in prison for a shooting that occurred in the area of the RTA Hub at 3rd and Main Streets in Dayton. Officers were on patrol in the area and heard a gunshot. They located a juvenile who had been shot. A co-defendant, Sean Walker, also indicted in the shooting, has a pending case set for a motion to suppress hearing in September.

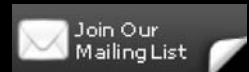
