## **Dayton Man Indicted for Shooting Death**

*State v. Perry Thompson, Jr., 2020-CR-2469*

**DAYTON, OH (11/12/2020)** – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **PERRY MAURICE ROLANDUS THOMPSON, JR.**, 25, of Dayton, has been indicted on counts for the shooting death of his cousin, Kyron Cannady, on August 9, 2020.

On the evening of Sunday, August 9, 2020, Dayton Police were dispatched to an apartment in the 1000 block of Salem Avenue on a reported shooting. Once inside, they were directed to the victim, Kyron Cannady, who had been shot multiple times. The victim was transported to the hospital where he later died from his injuries.

Witnesses were able to identify the defendant as the shooter. The two men had been in an argument earlier in the evening over a debt.

Today, the Montgomery County Grand Jury indicted the defendant for:

- Two counts of Murder
- Two counts of Felonious Assault
- One count of Having Weapons While Under Disability (prior drug conviction)

The defendant is currently being held in the Montgomery County Jail on a \$1,000,000 bond. He is scheduled to be arraigned on Tuesday, November 17, 2020, at 8:30 a.m.
