Dayton Man Indicted for Murder

State v. Phillip Raziel Sheehon Tyra, 2015-CR-1681

DAYTON, OH (06/12/2015) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that 20 year old **Phillip Raziel Sheehon Tyra**, of Dayton, has been indicted for the shooting death of 24-year-old Triston L. McDonald on May 27, 2015.

The defendant was a marijuana dealer and shot the victim during a drug transaction. Forensic evidence indicates the victim was shot four times, including a shot to the back of the victim's head.

Today, the defendant was indicted on:

- Two counts of Murder while committing felonious assault
- Two counts of Felonious Assault
- Two counts of Murder while committing Aggravated Robbery
- Two counts of Aggravated Robbery
- One count of Carrying Concealed Weapons
- One count of Trafficking in Marijuana

The murder, felonious assault and aggravated robbery counts also include 3-year gun specifications, because the defendant used a firearm during the commission of the crimes.

The defendant is currently in custody in the Montgomery County Jail, being held on a \$1,000,000 bond. He is scheduled to be arraigned on June 16, 2015 at 8:30 a.m.
