## **Man Indicted for Double Shooting in Harrison Township**

*State v. Caleb Willis 2015-CR-3965*

**DAYTON, OH (04/25/2016)** – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that 18 year old **Caleb J. Willis** has been indicted for shooting two victims in Harrison Township on November 27, 2015, killing one of them.

On Friday, November 27, 2015, the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office responded to a 911 call for help on Palisades Drive in the Northland Village Apartment complex. Upon arrival, at 1932 Palisades Drive, the deputies located a victim, 27 year old Shaun Benson, who had been shot multiple times. He was transported to the hospital where he died. Meanwhile, at 1928 Palisades Drive, the deputies located a second shooting victim. The second victim survived his injuries.

Further investigation determined the defendant was the shooter. The defendant was arrested in Hamilton County, where he is being held on unrelated charges of burglary, kidnapping, and weapons charges.

Today, the defendant was indicted on:

- Two counts of Murder
- Four counts of Felonious Assault
- Two counts of Aggravated Robbery
- One count of Tampering With Evidence

The murder and felonious assault counts carry a mandatory 3-year firearm specification because the defendant used a firearm during the commission of his crimes.

The defendant will be arraigned on May 10, 2016 at 8:30 am. He is currently in custody in Hamilton County on unrelated charges.
