

Income Withholding

Income withholding by employers is the single most effective method of child support collection. Ohio employers play a vital role in helping to secure the financial future of thousands of children. Working cooperatively to withhold and remit child support payments, you are a valuable resource in our efforts to secure these children's future.

Please remember to provide the employee name, the SETS case number, the court order number **AND** the payment amount for **each case** for which you are submitting a payment. If you are submitting one payment for multiple cases, you must provide the specific payment amount intended for each case.

It is the responsibility of the employer to deduct child support from the monetary payment which was earned and made payable for personal services. For more information on income withholding, see [this website](#).
