PROVISIONAL ORDER TO TRANSFER GUARDIANSHIP
[R.C. 2112.31]

This matter is before the Court on a Petition to Transfer Guardianship.

The Court finds that the ward, the ward's next of kin, and any other persons entitled to service have been properly served or have waived service of notice of the Petition to Transfer Guardianship. The Court further finds that no objections have been to the Petition to Transfer Guardianship.

The Court finds that the ward is physically present in, or is reasonably expected to permanently move to, the State of _____.

___ The Court finds that reasonable and sufficient plans for care and services for the ward in the other State have been made.

___ The Court finds that adequate arrangements for the management of the ward's estate in the other State will be made.

The Court finds that transfer of the guardianship to the other State is in the best interest of the ward and that the court of the other State is likely to accept jurisdiction of the guardianship.

WHEREFORE, the Court **ORDERS** that the Petition to Transfer Guardianship is hereby **PROVISIONALLY GRANTED** and that the guardian shall file to be appointed guardian in the other State.
