Dayton Man Indicted in Fatal Shooting and Shooting Nine Days Earlier

State v. Calvin Jones, 2018-CR-0372

DAYTON, OH (2/7/2018) – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **KALVIN JONES**, 22, of Dayton, has been indicted on multiple counts in connection with two separate shootings, one of which was fatal.

On Saturday, January 27, 2018, the deceased body of 21-year-old Michael A. Cook, of Dayton, was found in an alley in the 600 block of Brooklyn Avenue in Dayton. Residents reported hearing gunshots about two hours earlier. Within hours, the defendant was located, as well as the weapon used to shoot the victim.

Further investigation determined the defendant had shot at four juveniles during a robbery just nine days earlier in an incident in the 200 block of North Ardmore Avenue in Dayton. One of the juveniles was struck by a bullet. The victims were able to identify this same defendant as the shooter in that incident.

Today, the Montgomery County Grand Jury indicted the defendant on:

- Two counts of Murder
- Seven counts of Felonious Assault
- Four counts of Aggravated Robbery
- One count of Discharge of a Firearm On or Near Prohibited Premises
- Three counts of Having Weapons While Under Disability

The defendant is currently in custody in the Montgomery County Jail, being held on a \$1,000,000 bond. He will be arraigned on Thursday, February 8, 2018, at 8:30 a.m.
