## **Cincinnati Man Sentenced for Murder at Plush Gentlemen's Club**

*State v. Demetrius Williams, 2017-CR-2793*

**DAYTON, OH (2/9/2018)** – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **DEMETRIUS WILLIAMS**, 40, of Cincinnati, was sentenced to 29 years-to-life for his convictions on counts related to a double shooting in Harrison Township, in which one victim was killed.

During the early morning hours of September 4, 2017, the defendant and a number of friends traveled from Cincinnati to Dayton to go clubbing. Eventually, the group arrived in three vehicles at Plush Gentlemen's Club in Harrison Township. The defendant arrived in a separate vehicle than the victims arrived in. After all the men exited their vehicles, the defendant pulled out a handgun and fatally shot 20-year-old Pierre Jackson, as well as fired multiple shots at the other victim as he was running away. The second victim was struck by bullets multiple times.

On January 22, 2018, after a jury trial, the defendant was found guilty as charged on counts of Murder and Felonious Assault. On February 6, 2018, after a trial to the court, the defendant was also found guilty as charged on a count of Having Weapons While Under Disability. The defendant was prohibited from possession a firearm due to a prior drug offense conviction.

Today, the defendant was sentenced to a total of 29 years-to-life, meaning he will serve at least 29 years in prison before he will be eligible for consideration of parole.
