## **Dayton Man Indicted for Kidnapping, Robbery, Assaults**

***State v. Demarco Wright, 2018-CR-1554***

**DAYTON, OH (05/30/2018)** – Prosecuting Attorney Mat Heck, Jr. announced today that **DEMARCO WRIGHT**, 20, of Dayton, has been indicted on multiple counts from an incident that occurred on April 21-22, 2018 in Dayton.

On April 21, 2018, the defendant and the victim met at McGuire's Liquor Store on North Main Street in Dayton. They then went to the victim's home on Ashwood Avenue. The defendant then started fighting with the victim, eventually overpowering him, and forced the victim into a dog cage. Over the next several hours, the defendant demanded passwords and pin numbers for the victim's credit cards. The defendant also sexually assaulted the victim, before leaving the residence in the victim's car.

After the defendant left the victim's residence, the victim was able to escape from the dog cage and went to the home of a neighbor to call 911.

The victim's credit cards were used in Kentucky and Tennessee. Eventually, the defendant was located in Fulton County, Georgia, driving the victim's car. Atlanta Police took the defendant into custody after a pursuit that ended when the defendant crashed.

Today, the Montgomery County Grand Jury indicted the defendant on:

- Two counts of Aggravated Burglary
- Two counts of Aggravated Robbery
- Three counts of Kidnapping
- Two counts of Rape
- Two counts of Felonious Assault
- One count of Robbery
- One count of Grand Theft of a motor vehicle
- One count of Theft

The defendant is currently being held in the Fulton County, Georgia Jail and will be extradited back to Ohio to face prosecution. He is currently scheduled to be arraigned on June 14, 2018, at 8:30 am.
